of which King..... he is at this time a subject.

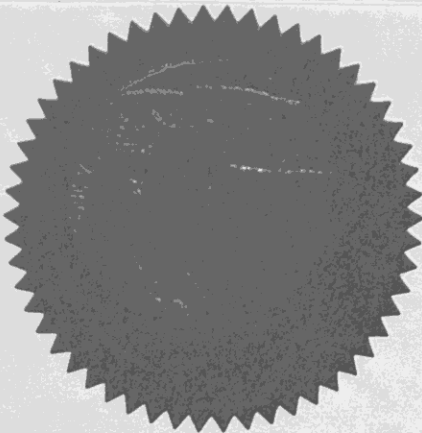
