In the name of God Amen the fifth day of July in the year of our
Lord 1754 I John Derennus of Paramor in the County of Bergen and in the
Govern of East New Jersey yomen being in good halt and perfect mind and
memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality
of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men ones to die do make
and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say principally & first of
all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of God that give it and my
Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christen and decent manner
at the discretion of my Executors not doubting but at the general Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it hat pleased God to bless me in this life I give
devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form I specify
it is my Will and I order that in the first place all my just Debt and small
Charges be paid and satisfied out of my moveables. Item I give and bequeath
unto Elisabeth my dearly beloved wife all my Reale and personell Estate that
if she should hapen to wante to sole or convey any part thereof as for as to sus-
tane her wante and after her decease as followeth. Item I give unto my son
Cornelus all my Realle Estate with the wife Lounie and Cuypons toled with he
is to pay for eighty pounds york money to the rest of my Children hereafter named
and that foure year of my wifes Dissor and if it should soo happon that I should
over live my wife than four years after my Dissor. Item I give unto my
oldest son son John five Shillings for his Fathers wuth doced therewith
and twenty pound to the two Children of my son Abraham that is to say out of
the eighty pound my son Cornelus is to pay for the lands at such time as shal be

mentioned that is teen pounds to my Grandson John and teen pounds to my
 Granddaughter Cathron both Children of my son Abraham. Item my son
 Cornelius is to pay unto my Daughter Jannetje now wife to Machel Hertie
 the sum of twenty pounds money aforesaid out of the aforesaid. Eighte pound or of
 above. Item to the Children of my Daughter Aeltje to wits Jacob and
 Elisabeth and Annatje betwens them twenty pounds as aforesaid. Item to my
 Daughter Elisabeth the sum of twenty pound out of the aforesaid money and to
 be payd as above is directed. Item as for my movebles that shall then be
 to be dividet as followeth a fift part to my son Cornelius, one fift part to
 the two Children of my son Abraham, one fift part to my Daughter Jannetje
 one fift part to the Children of my Daughter Aeltje, the other fift part to
 my Daughter Elisabeth. I Will that my Executor hereafter named do constitute
 my son Cornelius Doronus and my son in law ^{Machel Hertie} my Executors of this my last
 Will and Testament And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disown
 all and every other former Testament Wills Legacies and Executors by mee
 in any ways before this time named Willed and bequeth ratifying &
 Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament in Writte
 whereof I have herunto set my hand and Seal the day and year above writte
 Signed Sealed published and Declared by of John ^{the} Doronus 
 said John Doronus as his last will and testament
 in the presence of us the subscribers viz
 Dirck Day, Nicholas Rip, Phillip Schuyler.

Be it Remembred that on the seventh day of February in the year of our
 Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight Nicholas Rip one of the witnesses
 personally appeared before me Wm Ogdon duly authorized to take Wills & qualify
 Executors in Essex and Morris Counties and they being duly sworn on the holy
 Evangelists did Depose that he was present and saw John Doronus the Testator
 within named sign and Seal the within written Instrument and heard him
 publish pronounce and Declare the same to be his last Will and Testament
 and that at the doing thereof the said Testator was of sound mind and memory
 to the best of his knowledge and understanding and that at the same time
 Dirck Day and Phillip Schuyler was present and signed as did he sign
 a witness in the Testator presence. Wm Ogdon

Be it also Remembred that at the same time Cornelius Doronus
 and Machel Hertie the Executors within named personally came
 before me and were sworn to the due Execution & performance of the
 within Will and Testament according to Law. Wm Ogdon
