In the name of God Amen. I Polly Doremus of the township of Hohokus,.....

"Item, I give and devise unto Sarah Gotschius Doremus, daughter of Joseph Doremus and Polly Sutherland, all my real estate lying and being in the Town of Ramapo, County of Rockland and state of New Yorksupposed to be about fifteen acres, more or less, to be left in the care of my executors herein after named, until she be twenty-one years of age or on the day of her marriage if she should marry before that time and the proceeds thereof to be paid unto her yearly, but if the said Sarah Goetschius Doremmus should die before she be twenty one years of age leaving no issue, then it is my will that the said devise be equally divided between my two daughters Hannah and Jane share and share alike".

Executors: Garret H Zabriskie and my son-in-law Edward Murray.
