23 April 1743...The wife of Francis Francisco Bastian complains that Peter Nix is building on the place and refuses to let him have his crop off... (Vol. IV, p. 3)...12 September 1764...lease executed for land at Romopock to Peter Nex, lot 138, 50 acres, for 3 years from 24th March last, paying 10/ yearly. I've also seen this surname spelled Nax. Perhaps, if the Tappan Church entry for their marriage intentions is correct, Peter himself, b. in Germany, may have been the immigrant ancestor of this family.
