In the name of God Amen. I Harmon Nix of the township of Ameliasburgh, County of Prince Edward and Province of Canada, yeoman, Being of perfect mind and memory though deprived in some measure of bodily health, and knowing the uncertainty of human life, do make and ordain this, my last will and Testament, in form and maner following. that is to say I will and devise that my wife Sarah Nix do have all my household furniture and goods at Her own desparate forever. I further will and devise that the remainder of my land that is not deeded on lot Eighty four, supposed to be thirty two acres more or less, in the first concession, Township of Ameliasburgh and County of Prince Edward, that one year after the demise of my wife Sarah Nix, the afore said land be sold by my executors, and their title of said land shall be good and valid forver, and, if the demise of any of my executors before the sale of said land, then any persons appointed by him or them the same validity. I further will and devise that from the proceeds of the sale of said land that their be to my son Jacob Nix or his Heirs, the sum of fifty pounds of lawful money of Canada, also to my son John Nix or his Heirs, the sum of fifty pounds of lawful money of Canada. I further will and devise that all my farming utensils and stock be also sold and after all my lawful debts are paid, the balance there from together with the balance remaining from the before mentioned land be equally divided between my Daughters, and, if any one of my daughters are deceased at the time of said division, then that share be divided between Her Children,

and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Peter Dempsey junr and Abraham Nix my Executors to this, my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills made by me in testimony where of I have here unto set my hand and seal this fourth day of June in the year of our Lord. one Thousand, Eight hundred and fifty seven,— Signed, Sealed, and delivered by me, the said Harmon Nix, to be my last will and testament in the presence of us who have subscribed our names as witnessess in presence of the Tetator.
