

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN I Laurens Van Buskirk Yeoman being Sick of Body but of perfect Memory and understanding thanks be to Almighty God and considering the frailty of human life do make this my Last Will and Testament in the following manner. And first I give my soul into the hands of God who gave it and my Body I Commit to the Dust Nothing doubting but I shall Receive the same at the Resurrection, and as to the Rest of my Worldly Estate I dispose of and Bequeath it as follows viz. IMPRIMIS I give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Eva Van Buskerck the sum of forty pounds () Estate Likewise two cows and two Sheep and Thomas A. Van Buskerk and Peter Dedricks Vanamaker I appoint Sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament. Item I bequeath to my Eldest son Thomas Laurens Vanbuskerk my Gun and Bayonet and Bible and his Riding horse and my lands I give one half unto him likewise and the other half unto his Younger Brother to be Equally divided Betwixt them as they shall best agree Between themselves and in Case they cannot agree let them choose two indifferent Men and Let them make the dividend and he that shall have the (improve)ments shall help the other in Buildings or pay in Proportion to help therewith. Thirdly, I bequeath unto my Younger son John Lar Van Buskerk my other gun and likewise a Riding horse and one half my Land and Movables to be divided Equally divided as above he who Shall have the Improvements shall help the other in Buildings and Fourthly I Bequeath unto my daughter Allyte Van Buskerk the sum of Twenty Pounds to be paid when my Youngest son John shall come to the age of twenty one years two cows and two sheep to her and her heirs. Fifthly, I Bequeath Antye my daughter the sum of Twenty Pounds and two cows and two sheep the second year after my son John shall arrive at the age of twenty one () to be equally divided into five parts to be Equally paid unto in five Equal Payments the first to be paid (When my youngest son) John shall of age twenty one Years. Sixthly I Bequeath unto my daughter Jannetje Likewise the sum of (twenty pounds) in five Equal payments the first to commence to the age of (twenty one and)continue one payment every year until the said Twenty Pounds is paid. Seventhly I bequeath unto my (daughter Mary) the sum of twenty Pounds to be paid in five equal payments the first to commence the Second Year after my (son John shall arrive at the) age of twenty one and to Continue on Part Every Year until the whole is paid, Eightly I (bequeath unto my daughter) Antje the sum of Twenty Pounds to be paid in five Equal Payments as above. Lastly I Bequeath unto my (daughter Margaret the sum of) Twenty pounds to be paid in five equal Payments as above and likewise two Cows and two Sheep and() my last Will and Testament Confirming this my last Will and Revoking all other Wills and Testaments- (present twentieth day of November in the Year of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ One Thousand seven hundred () Signed() and Delivered by me the Testator as my Last Will and Testament in the Presence of us.
