here, has given me his impressions of the welcome given to the French officers and men in England. His expression of feeling is clearly genuine and cannot be attributed to any desire to flatter British readers, since he had no knowledge that what he said might find its way to a British newspaper. Lieutenant X. . . said:—

When we were sent to Portsmouth we had just returned from a three months' cruise in Eastern waters and were somewhat tired; but from the first minute our visit to England entirely refreshed us, body and soul. Our first surprise came while we were still on the high seas, seven or eight miles from the coast, when several large steamers, each containing at least 500 civilian passengers, came out to meet us and greeted us in the most friendly way. Nobody, even among the oldest officers, had ever seen that in any country, and it warmed our hearts. These boats turned back with us, and when we stopped off Spithead they were joined by many other boats, which steamed round our ships, while those on board cheered and called out greetings to us. The great crowds on the quays at Portsmouth and the warmth of the welcome that awaited us showed that we were really among friends, and that the Entente Cordiale was more than a diplomatic formula. I may tell you that all our young boys were deeply moved by that reception, which will never fade from their memories or from their hearts.

During our stay this impression was reinforced. The kindness of everybody was splendid. I can tell you that the men were profoundly touched to see that entertainments were provided for them as well as for the officers. Always until now our visits to foreign countries have been marked by a very wide difference between the receptions for the officers and the treatment reserved for other ranks. The English were the first to treat our men as well as we ourselves were treated. That will not be forgotten, and we are as grateful for it as our men.

The organization of the entertainments was marvellous. For instance, we were invited to a magnificent tournament at Olympia. Each of us was provided with a programme, splendidly printed and in good French; you can imagine how welcome that was to most of us, who do not understand English. By the way, articles, and even advertisements, in the Portsmouth papers were translated into French; is it not nice to have thought of that? Our trip to London, whither we were taken in 30 first-class motor-coaches, was a splendid piece of management. Our reception at Guildhall was marvellous. I could not believe my eyes (or my ears!) when I saw the crowd assembled to greet us when we came out of Guildhall. I could talk for hours about those few days. To put it shortly, our men and ourselves were absolutely delighted with the trip, and it will be for all of us one of our dearest memories. All that has been said by the newspapers gives only a faint idea of what it was, because it cannot convey the feeling which was at the bottom of it—that of a deep and true friendship existing between our two nations. That is what the English people made us feel.
